

# First Lutheran Church Council Minutes – December 12, 2023

Members Present: Laura Krauth, Sandi Mason, Cathy Wanderaas, Shane Reed, Sharon Hoffman, Doug Madison, and Vernie Madison. Members Absent: Stanley Dowse, Scott Montgomery, Abby Reum, and Jerald Peterson.

Pastor Bonnie led the devotion based on Psalm 90.

Minutes of the September and November council meetings were presented. Shane made the motion to approve with corrections made to change the date on the September minutes from 8/12/2023 to 9/12/2023; Laura seconded; motion carried.

Treasure's report was not available.

<u>Pastor's report:</u> Pastor presided at the memorial service for Gilbert DeSonia of Nashua. She officiated at the wedding of Brittany McKenny and Willam Richard in Great Falls.

# Committee Reports:

The evangelism/stewardship committees are planning to hold trivia games/tournaments three weeks in January and in February. They will have chili and rolls after church. Free will offering will be made available for people to donate.

Shane reported for the property committee Has not received a bill for repairs that have been done on the roof. Shane was also able to fix the outlets in the Sunday school room – a breaker had been tripped. Was reported that two lights in the lady's bathroom still need to be repaired. Shane also reported that he and his sons will begin demolition of the showers and bathrooms upstairs before the end of the year. He will keep the council posted as to what he finds, and as to what materials he will need to make the repairs.

#### Old Business:

Smorgasbord: Laura and Sandi reported on the Smorgasbord.

After the bills are paid, a donation of \$2500 should be able to be made to the church. \$353 was also made on the bake sale.

Cleaning: Pastor Bonnie will talk to the congregation during coffee hour after Christmas to let them know that formal cleaning days will not be held. Cleaning will be done when people have time to clean. The cleaning chart will be discussed and how to write down when and which areas have been cleaned.

<u>Faith & Family:</u> Sharon shared with the council a booklet compiled by Family Connections about all the available health, addiction & recovery, and mental health agencies and resources available in our area. Pastor Bonnie will contact the Region 6 office of Family Connections to see if we could get more booklets to have on hand.

<u>Constitution:</u> Cathy has completed all changes/updates to First Lutheran's constitution as per the model given by the ELCA. This updated constitution will be presented to the congregation for the first time at the 2023 annual meeting.

# New Business:

Shane reported to the council that he had been approached by the pastor of the Community Bible Church to see if their overflow traffic could park in First's parking lot. Pastor Bonnie brought up the subject of liability should there be injury and/or car accidents. Our insurance agent will need to be contacted to see what our policy states about another church sharing our parking lot and where the liability responsibility lies.

There being no other business to discuss, Cathy Wanderaas made a motion to adjourn, Shane Reed seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:50p.m.

Next council meeting will be on January 9, 2024.
